Responses to Navasota ISD Indoor Air Quality Recommendations.

1. Air conditioning filters will be replaced with a merv 8 filter to increase filter efficiency. The frequency of changing air filters in the District has been increased to every 3 to 4 weeks.
2. District is evaluating methods to introduce fresh air into return air ducts, this could include but will not be limited to increased fresh air intakes, evaluating increased air induction to classrooms etc.
3. Remove all air fresheners/odor neutralizers in offices.
4. Remove/ limit plants in building.
5. Storage of cleaning supplies shall be maintained in closed containers and secured closets when not in use.
